RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF THE COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL THERAPISTS OF BRITISH COLUMBIA MADE THE 23rd DAY OF AUGUST 2023 AT VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA

RESOLVED THAT, in accordance with the authority established in sections 19(1) of the *Health Professions Act* (the “HPA”), and subject to notice and to filing with the Minister of Health as required by section 19(3) and (6.2) of the *HPA*, the board amend the bylaws of the College of Physical Therapists of British Columbia as set out in the attached Schedule.

SCHEDULE

The bylaws of the College of Physical Therapists of British Columbia made under the authority of the *Health Professions Act* are amended as follows:

1. Section 8 is repealed and replaced by the following:

Terms of office

9. (1) The term of office for an elected board member is three (3) years commencing on the date of the first board meeting following that board member's election.
- (2) An elected board member may serve a maximum of three (3) consecutive terms.
- (3) Despite subsection (1), the term of office for every elected board member who holds office on the date this subsection comes into force is extended by one year.
